Re: UMA Core V0.9 IPR Review

Dear Ms. Jadrosich:

I am the sole owner and inventor of U.S. Patent Number 8,549,589 (the '589 patent) and pending U.S. Patent Application No. 14/027,744 (the '744 application), both titled "Methods And Apparatus For Transacting With Multiple Domains Based On A Credential." The '589 patent (including issued claims 1-16) and the '744 application (including pending claims 21-43) relate to Sections 3 and 5 of the User-Managed Access (UMA) Profile of OAuth 2.0.

In particular, these sections treat broadly on an authorization process distinct for an authentication process that manages privileges that are unique to the information being stored and can be further differentiated according to which party is seeking to access the information.

Pursuant to Article 6 of the Option for Patent & Copyright: Reciprocal Royalty Free with Opt-Out to Reasonable and Non discriminatory (RAND) in the applicable Kantara Initiative IPR Policies (the "IPR Policies"), I hereby withdraw from the license grant set forth in Section 4.1 of the IPR Policies, the claims of the '598 patent and the claims of the '744 application (as currently constituted and/or as may be amended during any subsequent proceeding(s)), and any claims that may be presented in any application(s) for patent of the United States claiming priority to, and/or the benefit of, the '598 patent and/or the '744 application. Accordingly, I will offer a license consistent with Section 6.2 of the IPR Policies.
